

## Blacktown & Districts Soccer Football Association Incorporated Individual Member Recognition Requirements Policy

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## 1. Purpose

1.1. To detail how a person is recognised by the Blacktown & Districts Soccer Football Association Incorporated (the "Association") as an Individual Member.

## 2. Scope

2.1. This policy applies to all persons that are not a Member of a Club and wish to remain or become a Board Director.

## 3. General

The requirements to be satisfied in order for a person to be recognised by the Association as an Individual Member are:

- (a) that the person be a natural person;
- (b) that within the period of four (4) years ending on the date on which the person applies to be recognised by the Association as an Individual Member (the "Application Date") the person has over a period, in aggregate, of not less than 3 years:
  - (i) demonstrated a commitment to football in general and a commitment to football in the region; or
  - (ii) demonstrated a significant commitment to the Association; or
  - (iii) demonstrated a significant level of support for the activities of the Association; or
  - (iv) demonstrated qualities of leadership and competence in the administration of sporting organisations; or
- (c) that within the period of four (4) years ending on the Application Date the person has over a period, in aggregate, of not less than 3 years served a Club or Clubs in any one or more of the following roles: office bearer, committee member or any other role or roles with any such Club or Clubs which the Board determines has, or have, represented a significant commitment or contribution to the Club or Clubs or to football.

Note to this policy:

A reference to a Club in this Resolution is a reference to a Club as defined in the Association's Constitution.

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
