

1. Purpose

1.1. The purpose of this policy is to outline the role of the Premier League Marshall.

2. Scope

2.1. This policy applies to the Premier League Marshall assigned by the HOME team to assist the Match Officials with the Technical Area in Premier League 1st Grade Matches.

3. General

- 3.1. Be 18 years of age or older.
- 3.2. Not be a registered member of the premier league playing squad.
- 3.3. Be wearing a blue vest.
- 3.4. Make themselves known to the Match Officials prior to the commencement of a Match, advising that they are the Marshall and ensure their name is displayed on the applicable match sheet.
- 3.5. Help the Match Officials control the Technical Area during the 1st Grade Premier League Matches.
- 3.6. Ensure that persons in the Technical Area adhere to the instructions of the Match Officials.
- 3.7. If persons in the Technical Area are not adhering to the instructions of the Match Officials, politely ask that the person undertake what the Match Official has requested.
- 3.8. If the person does not comply, the Match Official will deal with the situation.
- 3.9. NOT engage in any verbal or physical altercations.
- 3.10. NOT consume alcohol or smoke while acting as a Premier League Marshall.
- 3.11. Maintain unbiased opinions/views when performing duties and behave appropriately in accordance with this document and as a representative of their Club.
- 3.12. Conduct themselves in a manner that enhances, rather than injures, the reputation and goodwill of the BDSFA and football generally.
- 3.13. Clubs that fail to comply with these Roles and Responsibilities may be fined by the BDSFA or dealt with in accordance with the BDSFA Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations.
